

## **Dicloflame 2.5%**

Diclofenac sodium

Injectable solution

*Vials (Vet. Use)*

### **Composition:**

Each 100ml contains : Diclofenac Sodium    2.5g

### **Properties:**

Dicloflame is non steroidal drug with anti-inflammatory, analgesic, anti-rheumatic and anti-pyretic effect.

Dicloflame contains diclofenac sodium which is believed to be inhibiting cyclo-oxygenase pathway of prostaglandin synthesis.

This causes remarkable decrease in the amount of prostaglandin and in turn the response to pain and inflammatory reactions is abolished.

Dicloflame reach to the maximum plasma concentration within 1.5 hours after intramuscular injection.

No accumulation occurs in the body on prolonged administration of Dicloflame: as it is rapidly metabolized and excreted mainly in the urine.

Dicloflame is highly safe during the pregnancy.

All these properties collectively recommend Dicloflame to be the drug of first choice in the treatment of all cases accompanied by inflammation and fever.

### **Indications:**

1. All types of arthritis, rheumatism, myositis, tendonitis.
2. Acute pneumonia
3. Acute mastitis.
4. Post operative and post traumatic inflammatory conditions.
5. Acute enteritis in lambs and calves.

### **Contra-indications:**

Hypersensitivity to non steroidal anti-inflmmatory drugs.

**Side effect:**

Over doses may be resulted in gastro-intestinal disturbances.

**Dosage and administration:**

Dicloflame is injected by I.M. route

Cattle and horses: 4ml/100kg of body weight daily

Sheep, goats, calves and dogs: 1ml/25 kg of body weight daily.

**Pack:**

Glass vials of 10 or 100ml
